C: Come, Lord Jesus.

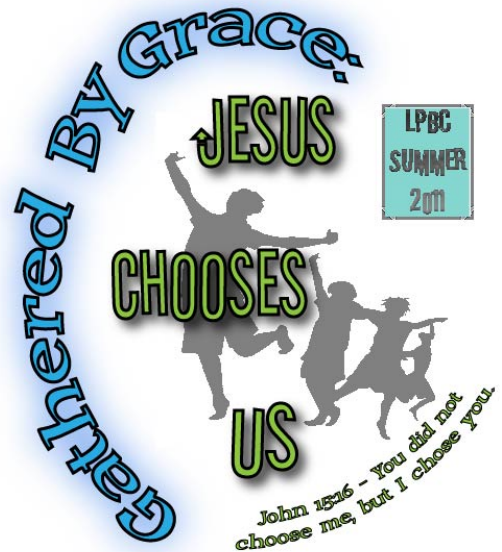
L: Jesus said, “Peace, be still!”
