Important Dates:

November 30th, 2011: Early Bird Registration

Deadline (Receive 10% off final total)

December 31st, 2011: Registration Deadline

January 30th, 2012: Contract and Deposit Due

Two weeks prior to trip: Return Trip Info Sheet

Lake Superior Sea Kayaking - Sr. High (entering 10-12 Gr.) & Adults

1. Minimum 6 participants, maximum 10 (number includes adult supervisor)
2. Cost: Member Church - \$350, Non-Member Church - \$405 for each youth; each youth group is allowed one Adult Supervisor at no cost
3. \$1,200 non-refundable deposit per group is required with signed contract
4. Luther Point will provide: two trained kayak guides (certified Lifeguard, Emergency Response & Wilderness First Aid by ARC), kayaks, PFDs, paddles, camping and cooking gear, safety equipment, transportation to and from Lake Superior, all necessary permits, and food.
5. Groups are encouraged to have guides lead LPBC summer theme Bible Studies, but may choose to do their own.

River Canoeing - Jr. High (entering 7-9 Gr.)

1. Minimum 6 participants, maximum 12 (number includes adult supervisor)
2. Cost: Member Church - \$325, Non-Member Church - \$380 for each youth; each youth group is allowed one Adult Supervisor at no cost
3. \$1,000 non-refundable deposit per group is required with signed contract
4. Luther Point will provide: two trained river guides (certified Lifeguard, Emergency Response & Wilderness First Aid by ARC), canoes, PFDs, paddles, camping and cooking gear, safety equipment, transportation to and from river, and food
5. Groups are encouraged to have guides lead LPBC summer theme Bible Studies, but may choose to do their own.
