



# Welcome to Luther Point Day Camp 2012

Greetings,

I am thankful that your congregation and Luther Point are partnering for a week of a Christ-centered and faith-filled Day Camp Program. This folder of information is meant to equip you for your week of Day Camp. Included in this folder is:

- **Day Camp Handbook:** This will give you a clear understanding of the expectations Luther Point has of your local coordinator and our Day Camp team. Read thoroughly as some information has been updated.
- **Reproducible Health/Authorization Forms:** These should be printed back to back, one per camper. These *must* be turned into the Luther Point Day Camp Coordinator upon the team's arrival.
- **Evaluation:** This should be filled out by the local coordinator and returned to Luther Point in the enclosed envelope following Day Camp.
- **Scheduling Sheet:** This *must* be filled out by the local coordinator and returned to Luther Point in the enclosed envelope at least two weeks prior to your Day Camp.
- **Copy of your Contract:** This is for your records.
- **Posters and Bulletin Inserts:** There are both full page, color posters to hang up and half page, black and white bulletin inserts to help you promote Day Camp.
- **Participation Certificates:** These are black and white so that they may be cleanly reproduced and given to your Day Campers at the end of the week.
- **Bible Study Overview:** This year's Bible study theme is SpiritLife. There is a one sheet overview of the five Bible studies the Day Campers will experience. This might be useful for you to use if you are trying to plan a thematic program for your preschool kids.
